Remember, only residents who received a first dose of AZ are eligible to receive a second dose of AZ.

Residents are being asked to book at <u>Renfrew County – COVID Vaccination Clinic Portal</u>, as this is the fastest way. **Please book an appointment for the earliest time available when you enter the portal.** ONLY if a person is unable to register online, they can call RCDHU at 613-732-3629 or 1-800-267-1097, ext. 202. Residents are asked to leave one message with their name and phone number, and someone will return their call as soon as possible.
