Pembroke Regional Hospital Foundation's *Catch the Ace* Drive-Thru Location Closed Permanently Due to Second Break-In

PEMBROKE – A second break-in at the Pembroke Regional Hospital Foundation's *Catch the Ace* Drive-Thru in less then two weeks has resulted in the decision to permanently close the ticket sale location at 775 Pembroke Street East.

PRH Foundation Executive Director Roger Martin said that the break-in occurred sometime between July 5th and July 8th.

In addition to physical damage at the mobile site, all *Catch the Ace* equipment at the location was once again taken including a tablet, a printer, a debit machine and a small amount of cash. These two break-ins have resulted in over \$5,000 in damages, Mr. Martin said.

"Theft from a local charity hurts everyone in the community at large," he added.
