PRH is able to host a variety of satellite services, including a dialysis unit operated by Renfrew Victoria Hospital. We also have a systemic therapy unit for the delivery of chemotherapy, supervised by local physicians and coordinated by oncologists from The Ottawa Hospital Cancer Centre. We offer clinical consultations via tele-medicine with the Ottawa Heart Institute, the Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario, The Royal Ottawa Hospital and others.

At PRH, we offer a variety of nursing careers. Many of our speciality departments offer mentorship programs for specialized nursing.

- Emergency Department
In-house critical care training, unit specific emergency clinical education; 20 mentorship shifts
- ICU Department
In-house critical care training, unit specific ICU clinical education; 20 mentorship shifts
- Acute Stroke & Rehabilitation Department
Stroke rehabilitation training, unit-specific rehabilitation and in-house stroke clinical educator; 150 hours of mentorship shifts
- Labour, Delivery, Recovery and Postpartum
Training support in neo-natal resuscitation, breastfeeding and labour support certifications
- Operating Room
Mentorship/training while completing operating room certificate



PRH offers employees health, dental and other benefits and continues to offer these benefits during retirement.

Loan Repayment Assistance

The Government of Canada offers Canada Student Loan forgiveness to eligible nurses working in under-served rural or remote communities. PRH is in a community designated for Canada Student Loan Forgiveness. You could receive up to \$20,000 in loan forgiveness over a maximum of five years.

What We Do At PRH

Supported by a staff of nearly 800 healthcare professionals and support personnel, Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) provides ambulatory care and acute services in emergency, intensive care, acute mental health, medical and surgical care and obstetrics.

PRH is a designated District Stroke Centre and offers regional programming in the areas of

- mental health services
- rehabilitation
- orthopaedics
- telemedicine
- cardiac care
- Ontario Breast Screening programs
- cancer care
- diagnostic imaging (including CT, nuclear medicine and MRI)

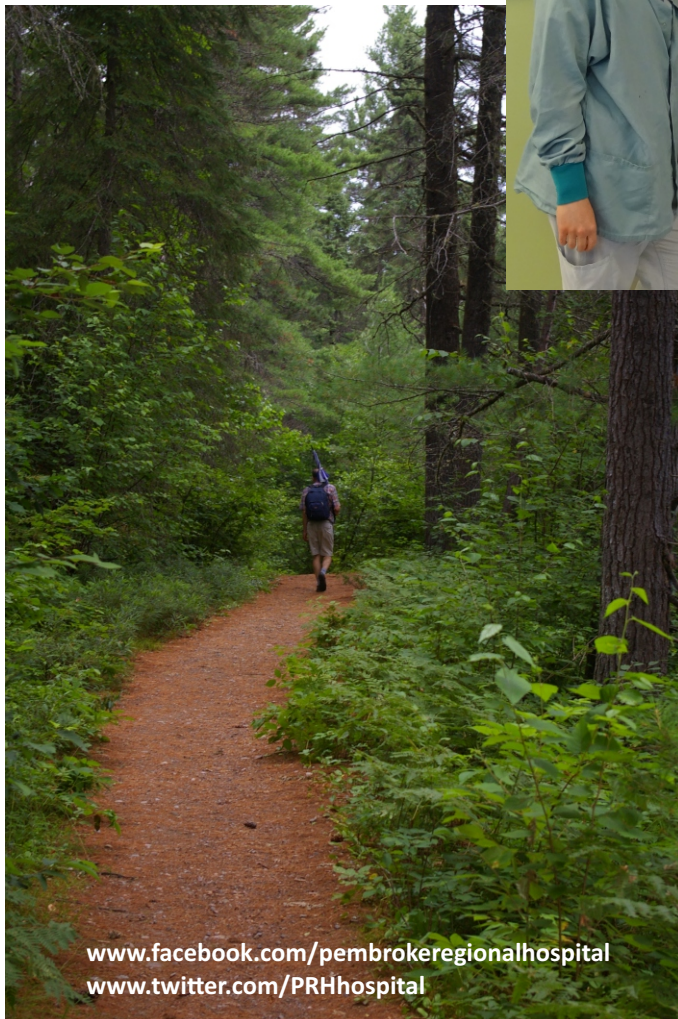
