• As part of an effort to conserve PPE (personal protective equipment), staff are now being asked to place goggles, N95 masks, ear-looped surgical masks and face shields in designated containers located on the clinical units for eventual reprocessing.

• Please note that a separate memo on Uniform Guidelines has been sent out with today's update. This memo is designed to address a number of questions that have been raised around work wear.

• As noted in yesterday's update, the hospital is waiving parking fees for staff and physicians this month. For those who pay for parking on a monthly basis and have already paid for April, this month's payment will be rolled forward to cover the parking fees for May.

• Staff log sheets to track those entering patient rooms are now posted outside all patient rooms. Staff are asked to please print their name and their "p" number for easy follow up should it be required.

• Until everyone is comfortable with the new Code Blue/Code Pink algorithms, frequent mock codes will be held, at least for the next couple of weeks. Staff will have a chance to review the new algorithm at safety huddles on each shift and will be encouraged to attend the mocks if their patient load permits.

• Over the next few weeks, the Clinical Educators will be running simulations of "Planned Intubation for probable or positive COVID patients". These will be held daily at 8 a.m. in the ICU. All health care providers are welcome to come and observe the new protocol, but they are specifically designed for those most likely to be involved with an intubation such as respiratory therapists, anesthesiologists, the ED physician group, and ED/ICU nurses.

Each exercise will include a walk through of processes developed specifically for planned intubations. This includes a pre-procedure huddle with team members, review of the appropriate PPE, a checklist review, review of the new intubation medication box, the new method of communication, and three various patient presentation scenarios with equipment needed for each followed by a practice intubation using the new protocols.

• In Renfrew County there have been ten laboratory confirmed cases of COVID-19 and one death to date. There have been 560 people tested, with 155 still under investigation. For the latest Renfrew County information on COVID-19, please visit <u>www.rcdhu.com</u>.

• In Ontario, as of today, there have been 4,726 laboratory confirmed cases of COVID-19. There have been 153 deaths and 1,802 cases have been resolved. A total of 614 patients are hospitalized, 233 of those in ICU and 187 of those on ventilator. A total of 81,364 people have been tested and 691 remain under investigation.
