

FULL-TIME INTERNIST AND LOCUM OPPORTUNITIES Pembroke Regional Hospital

Located one and a half hours west of Ottawa, the Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) delivers a broad range of acute, post-acute, outpatient and diagnostic services to a mixed urban and rural population of approximately 100,000 residents in the Upper Ottawa Valley.

Pembroke Regional Hospital is a full service medium size community hospital situated on the shores of the Ottawa River close to Algonquin Park. The hospital provides an array of diagnostic services including Nuclear Medicine, CT and MRI. The hospital has a busy emergency department, with 35,000 visits annually. Inpatients are primarily cared for by a hospitalist program. Full specialist support is provided by Anaesthesia, Internal Medicine, Surgery, Ob/Gyn, Psychiatry, Ophthalmology, Otolaryngology, Orthopaedics, Physiatry and Urology.



We envision growing our internal medicine program to include five general internists who will provide inpatient and emergency department consultations, and care for patients in the ICU. Internists often serve as the most responsible physician for intensive care patients. The department of internal medicine will provide a daily ambulatory clinic for urgent consultations, and post-discharge follow up. Internists share the interpretation of available diagnostic tests. This area has potential for growth once additional internists bolster the current team. Interested physicians will have the opportunity for a community-based practice including the possibility of providing specialist consultation at one of the community's Family Health Teams.

Pembroke Regional is a referral hospital in the Ottawa Valley. The Hospital is a designated District Stroke Centre and has a level 3 ICU that is staffed by a comprehensive multi-disciplinary team including nurses, physicians, respiratory therapists with access to all other allied health specialists. We have a well established referral protocol with local tertiary care centres in Ottawa.

Position Requirements

- Fully independent registration (or eligible for) with College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- Certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada FRCP(C) in Internal Medicine
- Experience working with teams and possessing strong interpersonal and collaborative skills.
