

## Pembroke Regional Hospital is currently seeking: Full-Time Otolaryngologist

The Hospital is situated on the shores of the Ottawa River close to Algonquin Park and provides an array of Diagnostic and Laboratory Services including: Nuclear Medicine, CT and MRI. Full specialist support including: a Hospitalist Program, Anaesthesia, Internal Medicine, Surgery, OBGYN, Psychiatry, Orthopaedics, Otolaryngology, and Urology.

Pembroke Regional Hospital (PRH) is a referral hospital supporting smaller hospitals in the Ottawa Valley serving a population of 100,000. The Emergency Department (ED) sees approximately 36,000 visits a year divided between acute care and fast track areas. We are a designated District Stroke Centre with a Neurologist on-call 24/7 through telemedicine. The ED/ICU is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team of nurses, physicians, respiratory therapists; as well as, social services, pastoral care, crisis intervention, speech, occupational and physio therapists. We have well established referral protocols with local tertiary care centres 140 km away in Ottawa.

## We currently have one full time otolaryngologist and are looking to recruit a second to join the team.

The practice encompasses a wide range of both adult and pediatric (over age 1) patients; in office, hospital out-patient, in-patient, and emergency department environments. A full range of diagnostic imaging services including X-rays, ultrasound (with U/S directed FNAB), nuclear medicine, CT, and MRI is available. Full audiology services are available.

There are 2 OR days per week allocated to otolaryngology and the department is fully equipped for middle ear and mastoid surgery, endoscopic sinus surgery, and facial nerve monitoring.

## **Requirements:**

- Fully independent registration (or eligible for) with College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO);
- Certified by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada FRCP(C)in Otolaryngology
- Willing to relocate to the area.

You may be eligible for Ministry Incentive Funding.
